Tammy & Ralph Stocks celebrate 15 years ministering among the Roma (Gypsies). Their ministry centers on building relationships with Roma and working along-side them. They help to meet their basic needs by providing clothing, fuel, food, medicines, and school supplies. Construction teams, skilled laborers, Vacation Bible School leaders, yard workers, and assistance in teaching English are needed. Pastors and theological professors can teach for a week at the Gypsy Smith Leadership Training School. In addition, women can provide outreach to ladies through a craft and fellowship time.

This includes helping Roma church planters with resources. Leadership training, vital for growth of leaders and their churches, is provided. Education is key in breaking the cycle of poverty many Roma find themselves in. Women can provide outreaches to Hungarian or Romanian ladies through a craft & fellowship time.
