

**Ecuador Health Mission

February 17-24, 2027



Who is Eligible?

CBFNC is collaborating with health professionals connected to partner churches across the state of North Carolina for a health and hygiene mission immersion to Ecuador.

Partnerships & Work

The team will work with Rescate Ecuador, a CBFNC endorsed mission organization. Rescate is a faith-asset-based community development organization in the Cajabamba region of Ecuador. Over the last two decades, they have partnered with numerous CBF churches on short-term mission immersions and partnerships. Their work focuses on health, education, farming, and social care.

Team members will coordinate clinics in various communities. Most workdays will be from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm, with lunch and other breaks incorporated into the day. Most recently Rescate Ecuador has opened a non profit clinic for the community that we will be helping with in various ways.

Location

Groups will fly into Ecuador's capital Quito, stay in the city of Riobamba, and work in the Cajabamba region.

Cost Breakdown: \$1,300-1,400

Trip expenses will vary slightly once the flights are booked and the number of participants is set for dividing transportation costs in country.

The trip fees will cover lodging, most meals, transportation, trip insurance, ministry projects, and most trip-related expenses.

2-Step Payment Process

1. \$250 non-refundable deposit to hold an airline and hotel spot (due September 28).
2. The remaining payment is due 40 days before the trip (due January 7)

Expectations

We are looking for participants willing to serve, grow, be flexible, and learn.

Each participant will be expected to attend all team meetings for preparation and team building prior to the trip. These meetings will take place online to accommodate the state-wide participation.

Members will be provided with a thorough team guidebook to prepare mentally, emotionally, physically, and spiritually for the experience.

Deadlines for paperwork and trip costs must be met on the set dates.

Please be prepared to be with the team for the entire trip. These trips are not designed for individual or small group outings. All team members will be expected to work and participate in group activities.
