

Collegiate Spring Break Ecuador Mission Immersion



Who is Eligible?

CBFNC is partnering with college students, young adults, faculty/staff of partnering universities and churches across the state of North Carolina for a mission immersion to Ecuador.

Partnerships & Work

Rescate Ecuador is a faith-asset-based community development organization in the Cajabamba region of Ecuador. Over the last two decades, they have partnered with numerous CBF churches on short-term mission immersions and partnerships. Their work focuses on health, education, farming, and social care.

Team members will be able to participate in various projects based on skills and interests, including building water filtration systems, volunteering in medical and hygiene clinics, working with children, community development, helping with art projects, and caring for indigenous churches.

Most workdays will be from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm, with lunch and other breaks incorporated into the day.

Location

Groups will fly into Ecuador's capital Quito, stay in the city of Riobamba, and work in the Cajabamba region.

Dates

With several colleges partnering, the trip will most likely span over several weeks, with groups coming and going as their spring break schedule allows.

Cost Breakdown: \$1,300-1,400

Trip expenses will vary slightly once the flights are booked.

The trip fees will cover lodging, most meals, transportation, trip insurance, ministry projects, and most trip-related expenses.

2-Step Payment Process

1. \$100 non-refundable deposit to hold an airline spot.
2. The remaining payment is due 40 days before the trip

Please be prepared to be with the team for the entire trip. These trips are not designed for individual or small group outings. All team members will be expected to work and participate in group activities.
