Furnishings

- Mattress* Twin/Double *Only married couples and small children of the same sex may share beds.
- Box Spring
- Bed Frame
- Set of drawers, shelves or other *Required if closet does not have shelving
- Kitchen table
- Kitchen chair (one per person)
- Couch or equivalent seating (in addition to kitchen chairs)
- Lamp (one per room unless installed lighting is present)

Kitchen Items

- One place setting of tableware (fork, knife, spoon) per person
- One place setting of dishes (plate, bowl and cup) per person
- Pots with lids and frying pan
- Mixing/serving bowls
- One set of kitchen utensils (such as a spatula, wooden spoon, knife, serving utensils, etc.)
- Can opener

Linens and Other Items

- One towel per person
- One set of sheets and blankets for each bed
- One pillow and pillowcase for each person
- Alarm clock
- Paper, pens and/or pencils
- Light bulbs

Cleaning Supplies

- Dish soap
- Bathroom/kitchen cleanser
- Sponges or cleaning rags and/or paper towels
- Laundry detergent
- Two waste baskets
- Paper Towels
- Mop or broom
- Trash bags

Toiletries

- Toilet paper
- Shampoo
- Soap
- One toothbrush per person
- Toothpaste
- Personal hygiene items as appropriate

Food

- Culturally appropriate, ready-to-eat food
- At least three days' worth of additional food supplies and stables
